Sorn Thary used to work in Malaysia twice. First time, she went to Malaysia was in 2008 to work as a house keeper. In 2016, She decided to go again as she learned about the job opportunity through her younger sister. There was a well-known recruiter in her village accompanied her to Phnom Penh to meet with a recruitment company. They helped her prepare all required travel documents. She worked as a cleaner for one man. Her first 7-month salary was deducted for all the preparation to work in Malaysia. In Malaysia, they took her passport, cell phone, money away from her. The house was locked day and night. There was no freedom for her. No holiday and not enough food (one chicken for 4 people, eat for 3-4 days). The work was hard and she was not allowed to make friends with other neighbors. She allowed to contact the family one a month. She was threatened from the manager when there were complaints from the customers about the service. They took overtime money from customers and did not provide her a bank account. She was rescued by the Malaysia police in November 2016 and was repatriated back to Cambodia in 2017. She is currently living with her family in Kratie province. After she returned from Malaysia, Sorn Thary faced some problems (family sickness, No job, unstable income, No secure/ decent house)

Thary and her family were living in her in-law's house. The living condition wasn't good because her in-laws are not happy for them to be on their property and sometime there were some conflicts. Last month, Thary and her husband moved out from the in-laws and built their own hut. The family are facing another problem because they are lacking of clean water. Their location is far from the river and the path to the river is also difficult. Thary and her husband want to have their own well, but they can't afford it as it is very expensive. The family can grow vegetables, raise animals if they have enough resources and water. They can earn more incomes to support the needs of the family. Thary would like to stay with her family in the province and she does not want to migrate again. Thary plan to raise chickens and she needs some material as below:

- 1- 2 chucks of chicken wire \$ 237.5
- 2- 50 sheets of thatch for chicken coop \$ 25
- 3- 2 small coops for baby chicken \$ 30
- 4- 10 chicken water feeders \$ 15

This is the materials for support to Sorn Thary.

For the female chicken raise the eggs. Thary need to protect the chicken eggs from the snack and the dog at night time, so all those can't eat the eggs.



We support Thary to raise the chickens and bough her the chicken 10 female chickens. Thary's so happy for getting the grant from Livelihood program then she can start to raise her family and no need to work as labor in other country again and she need to end the labor trafficking in her life and she want to be a model for her village too.
