Children (ages 0-12)

Youth Rally

8-12 volunteers, 10 days, Spring and Fall

So that more can benefit from the same programs taught at Youth Camp, each church in the north and south districts of Cambodia send up to 10 youths to Youth Rally (150-200 attend). Vacation Bible School (VBS)

8-12 volunteers, 10 days

We encourage teams to develop their own curriculum for a one day VBS workshop to be replicated in different churches. Come with songs, games, and craft supplies so these kids can learn more about God! Please also consider bringing health kits with shampoo, a bar of soap, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, hand towel, and nail clippers for each child.



Youth Local Church Focus

4-5 volunteers, 10 days

Teach leadership development skills, lead small groups, participate in existing youth programs, and join youths in evangelizing in surrounding villages at local churches throughout Cambodia.



Youth (ages 13-30)

Youth Camp

8-12 volunteers, 10 days, Summer (mid-May to mid-Aug.)

Each year, youths attend Youth Camp for fellowship, Bible study, worship, and seminars on leadership development, entrepreneurship, HIV/AIDS, and other topics. Come help lead Bible study and seminars for 250-300 youths during this week of fellowship and fun! Please also consider



Women

Maximum 12 women, 10 days

Volunteers from abroad frequently partner with Ubuntu Explorer Journeys in Phnom Penh for a week of fellowship, worship, prayer, spiritual reflection, and local site visits. During an eye-opening week of cross-cultural engagement, enjoy the opportunity to learn from and with sisters from Cambodia, exchange ideas, and be stretched in how you see God moving in the world.



Men

6-12 men, 10 days

At the Methodist Men's district and national retreats each year, we come together for worship, Bible study, fellowship, and discipleship training. The main purpose of our gatherings is to organize the Methodist Men in Cambodia at the local church, district, and national levels and to strengthen the witness of Methodist Men in the church and the larger community. Groups may sponsor participants for \$120/person (covers transportation, lodging, meals, supplies, and follow-up visits to churches and villages) and, if they so wish, volunteer to co-lead retreats.

Health

Community Health & Agricultural Development (CHAD) Medical Teams

8-12 volunteers, 1-2 weeks

Medical teams provide various types of medical treatment in the villages, including dental clinics, eye check-ups, immunizations, and pastoral care.

CHAD Medical Service Opportunities

1-2 volunteers, 1-2 weeks or more

We have a great need for doctors, nurses, and physical therapists to partner with provincial hospitals and the health department and to coach and mentor medical staff in all areas of medicine. Requests for specific medical skills vary according to the priorities of each province.



Agriculture

CHAD Individual Service Opportunities

1-2 volunteers, 1-2 months or more

We need open and flexible volunteers who are passionate about serving and learning in cross-cultural community and who are seeking to encourage, empower, and complement local volunteers in their ministry. If volunteers are also experienced in agriculture, business, communications, curriculum development, or health education, we will connect them with churches who would benefit from their skills during their stay.



Construction

Maximum of 12 volunteers, 2 weeks

We receive many requests for construction projects, but we only initiate construction when projects are fully funded. Please consider raising funds for or co-funding a project with another group! Some frequent project requests are:

- Wells (surveying and digging): \$200-\$2,000
- Fences: \$3,500 (bamboo & wire)-\$6,000 (concrete)
- Church repairs: \$3,500 - \$5,000
- Church construction
 - With land: \$25,000
 - Without land: \$30,000
- Parsonage construction: \$9,000
- Dormitory construction: \$12,000 - \$25,000



Teaching

Faith Engine Ministries (FEM)

1-2 volunteers, 4-14 weeks, Spring and Fall

FEM teaches automotive and engine repair skills to young people who dropped out of school so they can make a living by working at engine repair shops or by starting their own mechanic shops. Volunteers can help teach a small class of students in the spring or fall training classes.

Methodist School of Cambodia

1-2 volunteers, 6 months-1 year

We need volunteers to teach English at our Methodist School of Cambodia locations: Phnom Penh & Siem Reap.
