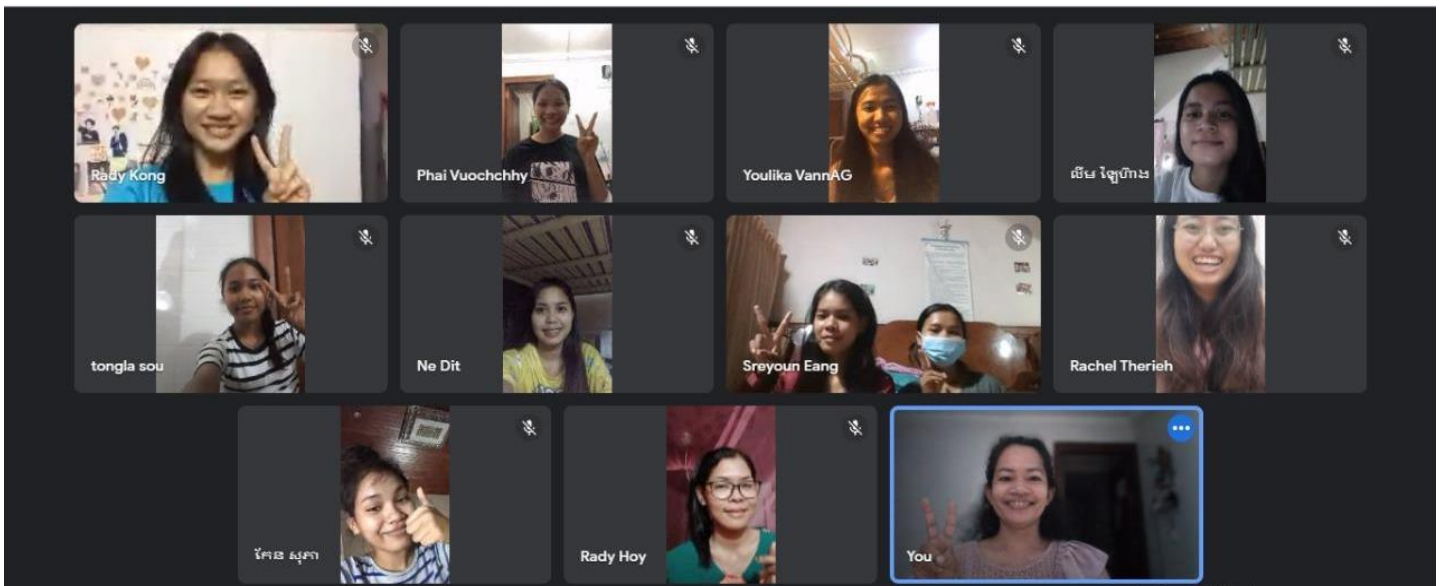
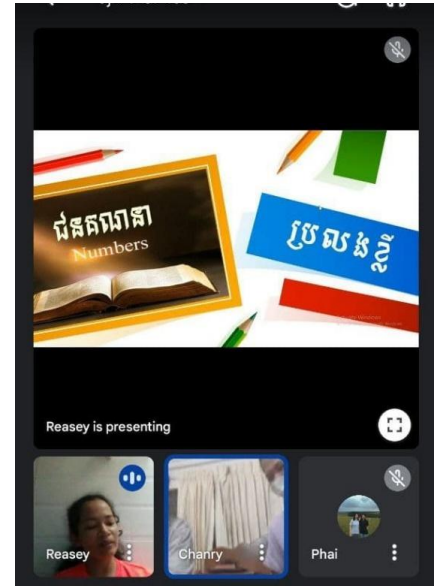


SWH Continues to Thrive Amidst Omicron!
