LOOKING AHEAD


As MCC (The Methodist Church in Cambodia) continues to grow, we (GBGM CMI) will focus more on the activities of MCC and humanitarian ministries as we decrease the monetary support we have been offering to be used as pastor salary supplement. We continue to walk this faith journey with MCC so that she will be a self-sufficient and self-governing Church.



COMMUNITY HEALTH AND AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT (CHAD)

A ministry to improve health, well-being, and food and economic security of rural communities by working through the Methodist Church in Cambodia.

CHAD program has served people in rural communities since 2004. With COVID and decreased financial support for this ministry, we decided to work with the remaining 25 communities until the end of 2023. During this period, CHAD will hand over the program oversight to the local communities and the Christian Social Concern Committee (CSCC) of the Methodist Church in Cambodia (MCC).

CLEAN WATER (Part of CHAD)

A ministry to help end water crisis and restore hope in various poverty-stricken provinces in Cambodia. (<https://umccambodia.org/cleanwater/>)

- 60 wells and 200 water filters (so far)
- 30% local contribution
- Health and hygiene training



With the help of Brockus family, we started this life-saving project in 2021. We provide access to clean water to help women's hygiene and protect children with safe-drinking water.

SUSANNA WESLEY MINISTRY (SWM)

With the belief that education is the key to break the chain of poverty and encourage the next generation to follow their dreams, we support youth and young adults through Susanna Wesley Ministry which embraces 4 programs.

SWH DORMITORY (Part 1 of SWM)

Susanna Wesley House (SWH) is a dorm ministry for young women from various provinces who aspires to attend universities. We provide scholarship, safe place, and Christian community for about 20 young women who would not have been able to attend university without the support of SWH. We have thus produced 7 graduates who are serving as role models for many other young women. We look forward to more Christian young women entering the society to make a difference in Cambodia.

SHINE PROJECT (Part 2 of SWM)

Shine Project (launched in 2021) is a ministry to empower and offer vocational trainings, education, and leadership for young women (16-25 years) who did not complete high school due to financial reasons. (<https://umccambodia.org/shine/>)

We offer various vocational trainings – government approved license in Khmer food, barista, western baking, or hair/makeup. The participants are encouraged to dream and pursue their dreams as they learn to view themselves through the eyes of God.

SUNDAY SCHOOL CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT (Part 3 of SWM)

With MCC children committee, we are working on developing a 3 -year Sunday School curriculum which covers stories from Genesis to Revelation including Christian value teaching (video), children’s worship song (video), and PDF copies of Bible lessons.



PRESCHOOL PROJECT (Part 4 of SWM)

The goals of MCC Preschool Project are twofold: (1) to offer quality Christian education for pre-school children in their formative age; (2) to assist Methodist Church in Cambodia (MCC) become self-sufficient by creating a money-generating business within individual churches.

- From 2023 (new)
- Example of self-sustainability
- Internal renovation and exterior work
- Curriculum development



We will launch this pilot program in the year of 2023 within the city of Phnom Penh. We will work closely with MCC to select a suitable church to start a preschool for an income generation project while serving young children in the community.

STREET CHILDREN MINISTRY

A ministry to share the love of God by funding children's education, teaching vocational skills, and providing health care to the sick and undernourished.

In 2021 and 2022 we supported the school to renovate its classrooms and library with new painting, lighting, and fan system. With a newly renovated stage area, the school will serve the neighboring community as a gathering place and community center.



PROJECT ARK

A ministry to tackle poverty as a culprit of human trafficking by equipping and restoring livelihood and dignity through the construction trade while introducing quality, affordable, and vocational skills training. (<https://umccambodia.org/ark/>)

ARK program has been able to provide vocational training, housing, community inclusion, and introductory Bible lessons to human trafficking survivors while they have lived in the ARK dormitory.

WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT

Working with Methodist churches, we offer leadership trainings and overseas educational opportunity to empower women in Cambodia.

It has been a challenge to implement the programs of women empowerment during the season of Covid-19 pandemic. Along with MCC, we plan to reach out and work closely with women in various villages, who are most vulnerable and majorly affected by the pandemic.

CHURCH PLANTING

MCC and GBGM have collaborated to establish the very first Methodist church in Mondulkiri province where about 60,000 Khmer and Punong tribe reside.
