He used his water pond as a source of water to grow his plants. Although dry season is approaching, he already harvested most of his crop during the past months hard work. He is so happy that chickens and ducks are getting many again. Despite weather and season effects were unpredictable due to climate change, these never stop him to try again and have a chance to earn and learn.
