Empowering young generation (Volunteer Nom Rothana)

My name is Nom Rothana, I am 20 years old. I have 5 siblings. My mom and dad divorced when I was 10 years old. After my parent divorced, one of my younger brother and I moved to live with my grandmother. Because my family condition, I just finished grade 5. My grandmother had no effort to send me to school, so this situation forced me to stop from school. I got a job when I was 14 years old. I was hire to sell the clothes at the market. I earned a little wage to help my grandmother to raise my younger brother. In 2021, I moved to work in Phnom Penh and I got to know one of CSCFO School teacher, Khun Thary. She helps me and trained me for Khmer Traditional Dancing. With this Traditional Dancing Skill, I can earn some money to support my daily life. Later on, Street Children Ministry needs a volunteer to teach the children, so I got a chance to volunteer teaching the student in grade 2. Working with CSCFO school for many months, the Street Children Program connect me with Shine Project(Program of GBGM). Through this opportunity, I got the support from Shine Project to study Salon/make up skill. I love this skill. Thank you so much CSCFO, Street Children Program and Shine Project that help me to reach my dream.

Computer Class Updates

Last year Street Children Ministry Program opened the computer class. We taught 6 youth volunteers of CSCFO School and 3 youths from outside CSCFO for free. The purpose we started this class, we want to help CSCFO to be self-support through this income generation activity. On the other hand, we saw the need of young people who live surrounding CSCFO school. First we trained these 6 young people to become the teacher for the computer class, so that they can help other children and young people. During this quarter, one of youth volunteer started to open a new class. She is freshmen at university study(GBGM scholar) in the morning, and she is CSCFO school teacher teaching grade 3 in the afternoon, but she manages her time well. She opens for 2 classes, morning class at 11:00-11:30 am and afternoon class at 4:00-4:30 pm. She got 5 students registered for her class. These 5 students also pay some money in monthly for this class. We keep pray for the CSCFO young people to have wisdom and have a commit for this class. We want expand this class to help more young people and children. And we want to help CSCFO to be self-support.

In this quarter, CSCFO school closed for the summer vocation from April 1-17. It was also a big ceremony celebration in Cambodia "Khmer New Year". Most of our student from the province, they move to Phnom Penh to find the income and they have no stable job. They are the labor worker, seller, transportation driver, security guard, factory worker and garbage collector. Therefore, for every big ceremony or occasion, they visit their hometown. However, our students have to follow their parent but some of our students instead of going to hometown, they joined CSCFO traditional dancing program to raise fund for CSCFO work and support their family.



After vacation, we also faced the challenges because some of our students did not return back to school due to follow their parent decision. We did the follow up and household visited to our student renting room to talk with the family and encourage them to concern about their children education. And then, some of our student return to school. In this quarter, we did 1 monthly exam and 1 semester exam for our students. Through these exams, we found that our children got better result than the first quarter. As the school teamwork, we also took a monthly meeting to share our monthly achievement, challenging/solution and planning. Our Education Team worked to help the children to have the better result. The team also help strengthen one another when teachers found the weakness during their teaching.
