BEK CHAN FOLLOW UP

In December of 2023, the CHAD Team did an assessment for Clean Water Project for Bek Chan Village. This community is one of the remote villages in Banteay Meanchey. During the rainy season, the village suffered difficulties from flooding. On the other hand, during the summer season, dry and hot weather gave them a hard time having water sources throughout the village. With this need, residents were pressured to buy water for their daily needs.

One year later CHAD Team conducted a follow up visit to see the beneficiaries of the clean water project.

The soil in Bek Chan is not conducive for farming but the beneficiaries make do with what they have. They get soil from outside the province and put them in jars and they can plant vegetables for their subsistence this way.

The beneficiaries have a shot at improving their lives this way and earn a living





BOUNGTRAH FOLLOW UP

This project was completed in January 2024. The beneficiaries struggled a lot during the dry season with no access to clean water whatsoever. Most of the beneficiaries have land which they can now cultivate vegetables such as eggplant, pomelo and other vegetables.

This project did not come without its challenges, the water bed was extremely dry during the time of digging that for a moment we almost lost hope of finding water in some of the homes, but everything turned out fine and the beneficiaries have water throughout the dry season which comes as a relief to many of the individual and their families and neighbours





SANG RAING FOLLOW UP

The Sang Raing project is a success story. As CHAD team went for the follow up, we saw how the families had improved their lives with the wells that had been dug. They had started planting morning glory, raising chickens and began tilling their small plots of land and watering their animals.

These wells will significantly improve the lives of the families and not in a small way. All in all it will strengthen their participation in their own lives and give them one less thing to worry about in the long run.

The road was very muddy and unpassable as it is the rainy season.



SVAY RIENG

FOLLOW UP

The Svay Rieng project was completed in 2021 in two villages Chouk Sar village and Chheu Teal village

During the digging process all the wells were using hand held pump as electricity had not reached these

villages yet. At the time of the follow up majority of the beneficiaries have switched to motor operated wells. This is because most of the time the younger people head out to the cities and only the older people are left in the villages and it is much easier for them to operate the motor operated wells.

Out of 20 wells only four wells had significant damage but the beneficiaries are looking for funds for the repair of these wells.
