By His grace, I became part of His great work, not by my own strength, but as a small drop within His greater wave that is the mission of God.

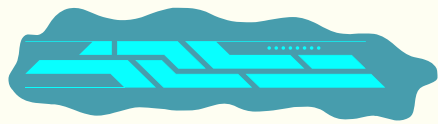


## Ripples of Service - Ministry in Action

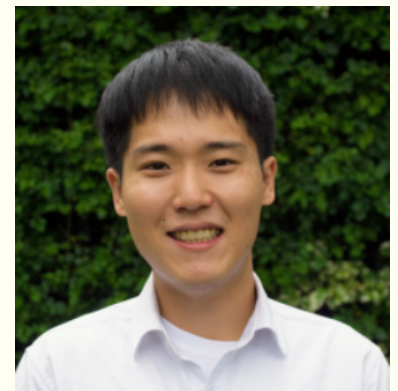
## Wave of Missio Dei
